Topic: Is Anyone Out There

What we have been doing this term:

This term's topic has been 'Is anyone out there', we have been focussing on space and including this in all areas of our curriculum.

In English this term we read 'The Tiny Astronaut' where we explored lots of different sensory experiences for each planet. Each week we have continued to learn about space through stories, songs and discussions. We have also been focussing on our early handwriting skills, continuing to work on our individual handwriting tasks and focussing on building our hand strength and dexterity with dough disco.

In Maths we have been learning about 2D shapes. As a class we have been learning how to name shapes, using our voices and communication boards to recognise and describe shapes. We have looked at how to use shapes for a purpose, for example building a rocket. We have also enjoyed singing our very catchy shapes song!

We have loved exploring the different holiday experiences that happen during the autumn and winter season, some of these have been bonfire night, thanksgiving and Halloween.
