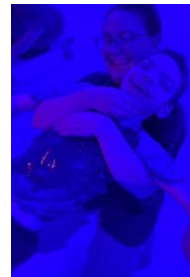
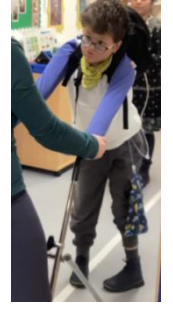
This term began by Blaise class marking the New Year with some glitter cannons and powder paints in balloons which we popped over damp card to create some celebratory posters – such messy fun.
