What's been going on?

This term Dover Class have been continuing the topic of reduce, reuse, recycle. This has included a trips to the furniture project and an upcycling shop. We learned about what happens to our furniture and other donated items after we have donated them. We have also been looking at festivals, and have been learning about pancake day and Easter. We have been finding out the history of them, and why we celebrate them.

In English, we have been looking at texts about our topic of reduce, reuse, recycle. Students have been looking at the texts, and practicing their comprehension skills. We have also been writing letters to thank the staff at the furniture project for a wonderful trip.

In maths, some students have been practicing adding two digit numbers using a number line, and the others have been practicing adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers using column methods.

During our cooking sessions, the students have enjoyed widening their skills of following a recipe, cutting with sharp knives, making pastry, using the hob, and weighing and measuring. The students showed that they can work together in groups and independently to produce high quality and delicious recipes, whilst also remembering the importance of food hygiene and kitchen safety. The class just love cooking and are keen to sample their dishes and share them with home.
