Oliver went out to Home Bargains to find some party items for prom.

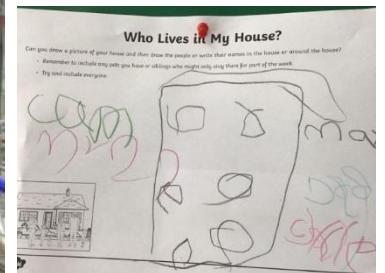
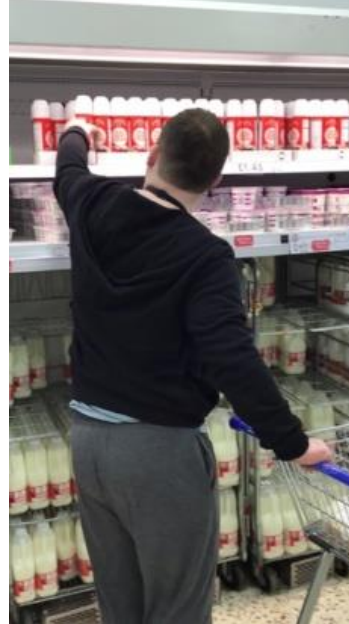
