## What we have been learning this term:

At Earth Trust and Smelly Wellies there has been an opportunity to look after the animals and learn about edible plants growing in the wild.

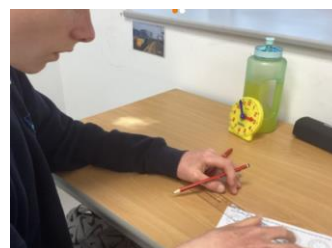
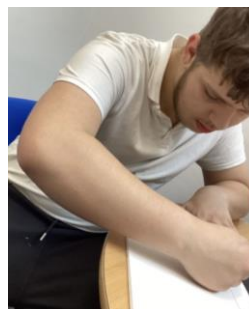
A local artist visited school to work with students on a collaborative 'Birds of Flight' project which will be on display at Thatcham Discovery Centre.
