Cameron and Oliver made cheese straws for our World of Work event and people really enjoyed them.

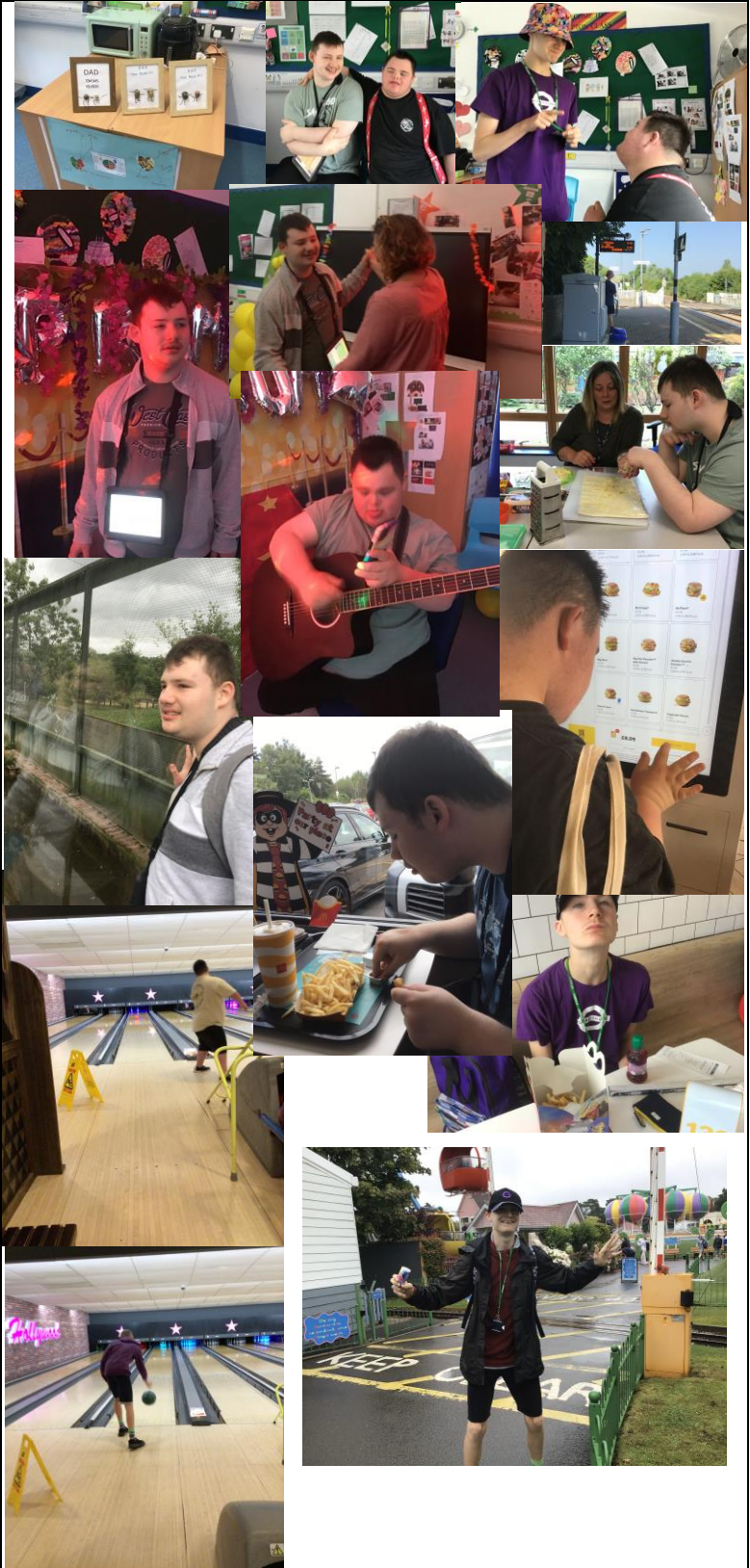
Oliver had his last few sessions with the shared lives team. They threw Oliver a party on his last day just to show how much they had enjoyed working with him, it was lovely.
